1. Statement of Intent

At Rossington St Michael's CE Primary School, it is our policy that school uniform must be inclusive, non-discriminatory, and supportive of all pupils. Our aim is to ensure every child feels welcomed, accepted, and able to fully participate in school life.

All pupils are expected to wear school uniform when attending school or participating in school-organised events. However, uniform items **do not need to feature the school logo** and **can be purchased from any retailer**, not just the suppliers listed below.

A complete list of uniform items, including PE kit, is provided at the end of this policy.

2. Aims and Objectives

This policy is designed to:

- Promote equality, inclusion, and a sense of school identity
- Ensure uniform is affordable, practical, and accessible for all families
- Comply with the Equality Act 2010 and the latest DfE guidance on school uniform (2021)
- Avoid discrimination on the basis of protected characteristics

3. Equality and Inclusion

In line with the Equality Act 2010, and to ensure fairness and inclusivity, we:

- Do not assign uniform items based on sex, allowing pupils to wear what they feel comfortable in
- Ensure uniform options are inclusive of gender identity and religious beliefs
- Allow adaptations to the uniform on medical, cultural, or religious grounds
- Permit long hair for all pupils and request that it be tied back when appropriate
- Allow pupils to style their hair in a way that is appropriate for school and aligns with their identity
- Allow modest swimwear options for religious or cultural reasons
- Permit religious head coverings (e.g. headscarves or turbans)

4. Affordability and Accessibility

We recognise our duty to ensure that uniform costs are reasonable and do not create barriers for families. Therefore, we:

- Minimise requirements for branded or unique items
- Allow all items to be worn without a logo, provided they match school colours
- Limit any distinctive items to affordable, long-lasting items (e.g., ties)
- Avoid specifying brands or retailers
- Keep optional branded items to a minimum
- Avoid differences in uniform based on year group, house, or class
- Do not require specific items for extracurricular activities
- Offer a Uniform Bank of second-hand items, available free to all families
- Avoid frequent changes to the policy and consult parents before any major updates

5. Jewellery, Hair, Make-up, and Nail Varnish

For health and safety reasons:

- Jewellery is not allowed, **except** for:
 - o One pair of small stud earrings in pierced ears
 - o Items of religious or cultural significance (to be discussed with school staff)
- Earrings must be removed for PE—staff are not permitted to remove them
- Hair ornaments should be discreet and in school colours
- Make-up and nail varnish are not permitted in school

6. Footwear

• All pupils must wear **plain black shoes or trainers**, without logos

- Black boots are allowed in cold weather, but if they are bulky or impractical indoors, pupils may be asked to change into PE shoes or school shoes
- Open-toed sandals, platform soles, or high heels are not allowed for safety reasons

7. Parent Responsibilities

Parents are expected to:

- Ensure their child wears the correct school uniform and PE kit
- Label all clothing and footwear clearly with the child's name
- Ensure that all items are clean and in good repair

If any family is experiencing difficulty acquiring uniform, we encourage them to contact a senior member of staff in confidence. We will do all we can to support families through the Uniform Bank or other means.

Pupils who arrive without the correct uniform may be loaned appropriate items from school. The same applies for missing PE kit. Parents will be contacted to discuss the matter if the issue persists.

We value and respect families from all backgrounds and faiths. If you would like to request a change or exemption from the uniform policy, please speak to the Headteacher.

8. The Role of Local School Board

The LSB:

- Supports the implementation of the school uniform policy
- Ensures compliance with equality legislation and affordability guidance
- Reviews and approves significant changes to the uniform policy
- Ensures the policy promotes practical, inclusive, and safe dress

9. Encouraging Uniform Use

We work in partnership with parents to encourage pupils to wear school uniform and understand its role in promoting identity, equality, and readiness to learn.

Our Uniform Bank provides high-quality pre-loved uniform items, free to any family in need.

11. Uniform List

General Uniform

- Yellow polo shirt (EYFS, Year 1 & 2 all year round)
- Grey trousers, skirt, or pinafore
- Burgundy cardigan or jumper*
- Grey tights/socks or white socks

Summer Options:

- Yellow gingham dress
- Yellow polo shirt with grey shorts

Key Stage 2 (Years 3–6):

- White shirt with school tie*
- Grey trousers, skirt, or pinafore
- Burgundy cardigan or jumper*

Shoes

- Plain black school shoes or black trainers with no logos
- Plain black boots (indoors at staff discretion)

PE Kit

- White T-shirt
- Blue or black shorts
- Plain blue or black tracksuit (for cold weather)
- Change of socks
- Trainers (for outdoor PE)
- Long hair tied back
- Earrings must be removed on PE days

PE kit should be brought in a separate bag and kept in school.

Note: Your child's teacher will inform you of PE days in advance.

Bags

- Small reading book bag (brought in daily)
- No large rucksacks, due to limited cloakroom space
