

Primary French Lesson Plan

Lesson objectives

To introduce the aim of the unit 'Les glaces'. In this lesson, pupils will learn how to name (with accurate pronunciation) and remember the first five (out of a total of ten) ice-cream flavours in French.

Graded activities

- Introduce aim of unit. In this lesson the children will learn how to name five common ice-cream flavours in French. The following lessons will then move onto learning the next five and then how to say they would like an ice-cream, specifying which flavour and whether they would like a cone or a small pot/tub. No previous French knowledge is necessary. Ask the children to guess in English what the possible flavours chosen for the lesson might be before starting the PowerPoint. <u>5 mins</u>
- Using the 'Les glaces 1' PowerPoint provided, start the first lesson. Pupils will learn how to recognise, name and hopefully remember five common ice-cream flavours in French. See Teacher Support Notes for a full lesson breakdown. <u>25 mins</u>
- An optional extra challenge section is provided at the end of the lesson along with a choice of differentiated worksheets to consolidate learning. See Teacher Support Notes for suggestions. (5-10 mins minimum)

PLENARY: Can the children now remember and say 5 common ice-cream flavours in French? Do they remember what these mean in English?

Resources required

- PowerPoint.
- Differentiated worksheets one per pupil (if teachers wish)

Suggested consolidation exercises/games/songs

- Create a wall display of ice-cream flavours and label them in French.
- Make their own ice-cream cone out of paper.
