

Primary French Lesson Plan

Lesson objectives

To start the unit and introduce the eleven masculine nouns with the indefinite article/determiner for popular food and drink typically offered in a French salon de thé.

Graded activities

• Start introduction of new language. The key vocabulary for this unit has been divided over two lessons. The nouns and determiners (indefinite articles) for a variety of masculine foods/snacks and drinks are listed on the support notes and are all introduced at this stage via the 'Au salon de thé 1' PowerPoint. There should be plenty of oral re-enforcement with all children participating. See support notes for PowerPoint breakdown and guidelines on how to best use the slides.

<u>35 mins</u>

• To consolidate the new language, play the snap card game in pairs and/or complete the simple desk-based activities provided. See support notes.

10 mins

PLENARY: Can the children remember what they have learnt today? How many of the foods/snacks and drinks introduced this lesson can they remember? Not forgetting the masculine articles/determiners.

Resources required

- PowerPoint.
- Snap card game (one set per two pupils).
- Desk-based activities one per pupil.

Suggested consolidation exercises/games/songs

• Create a salon de thé inspired based display.
